**Meeting Summary - Principal Conclusions & Recommendations**

- The Subcommittee agreed to meet again on January 7, 2008, at 2 PM in the same location, in advance of the full QGMC Meeting on the same date.
- A presentation and full discussion on the “Draft EIS Document for Quantico” should be scheduled for that meeting. The schedule of future EIS actions was reviewed.
- Support staff/committee members should contribute to assembly and discussion of a “projects list or matrix” of all relevant/related transportation projects in the Quantico area..

**Meeting Summary – Principal Conclusions & Recommendations**

- The Subcommittee concluded that it would be helpful to have a clearer understanding of what time frame the full QGMC expected for work to continue and conclusions to be presented for further/future action.
- The Marine Corps Base Quantico is conducting an “Encroachment Study’ at the present time. Committee members requested more information and an update on this matter.
- Various studies & actions currently underway were reviewed and discussed, including the Route 1 Transportation Study (FAMPO), Hot Lanes (VDOT), Prince William County bond issue and planning actions on Route 1, Russell Road & Quantico Base Projects, and Stafford County Redevelopment Study on Route 1.
- There was general discussion among the group regarding the challenge of carrying out transportation projects prior to the 2011 BRAC completion date at Quantico. Discussion focused on identifying “cost effective projects” which could address some of the transportation needs in a timely fashion.
- Subcommittee members were requested to formulate conclusions on what is needed to accomplish transportation goals so that OEA might be able to respond with assistance or recommendations.
